

# CITYWIDE INCLUSIVE SANITATION (CWIS) SCALING AND SANITATION INNOVATION

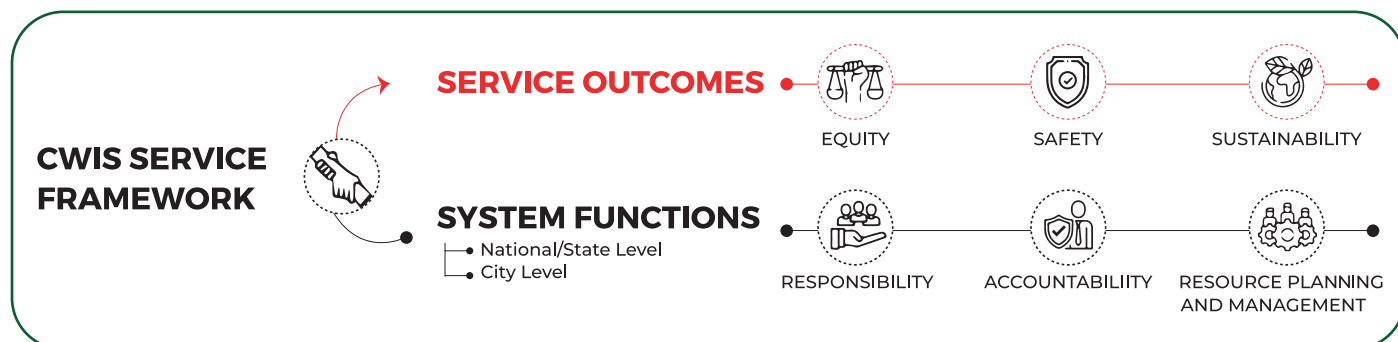
## ABOUT THE PROJECT

Environment and Public Health Organization (ENPHO), with the support of the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation (BMGF) and in partnership with International Training Network Bangladesh University of Engineering & Technology (ITN-BUET), is implementing the project “Citywide Inclusive Sanitation Scaling and Sanitation Innovation” in Nepal. With around 89.5 percent of Nepalese population relying on non-sewered sanitation services (MICS 2019), the proper management of fecal sludge remains a challenge for achieving the Sustainable Development

Goal (SDG) 6 target, ensuring safe sanitation for all, considering a full sanitation service chain. To meet the SDG 6.2 targets, skilled human resources in every aspect of FSM require significant attention. Thus, the project aims to build the capacities of relevant stakeholders so as to propagate the Citywide Inclusive Sanitation (CWIS) approach at the local level and support them in creating an enabling environment for the implementation of CWIS thereby improving public health.

## CWIS

Citywide Inclusive Sanitation (CWIS), a new and emerging approach in the sector of sanitation, is a concept to identify key sanitation challenges and mitigate them effectively to ensure safe sanitation for the growing urban areas in the world. Furthermore, the approach helps in identifying the best possible sanitation solutions for sustaining different initiatives. It focuses on providing access to and benefits from adequate and sustainable sanitation services along the entire sanitation service chain for protecting public health.



## PROJECT GOAL

The goal of this project is to catalyze achieving Sustainable Development Goal 6.2 outcomes to ensure safe, adequate, equitable, and sustainable sanitation for all with a special focus on marginalized communities, gender, women, girls, and children.

## PROJECT OUTCOMES

- Established ENPHO as a nodal capacity building and research agency
- Developed, updated, and contextualized training manual, module tools, and knowledge product on CWIS and FSM with a special focus to the government and municipal officials
- Build capacity of municipal and government officials and private sector professionals by organizing customized capacity building/training program
- Generated evidence, documented best practices on CWIS and FSM
- Transferred knowledge and skill to selected countries in South Asia, South East Asia, and Sub-Saharan Africa
- Established FSM and CWIS mentor cities

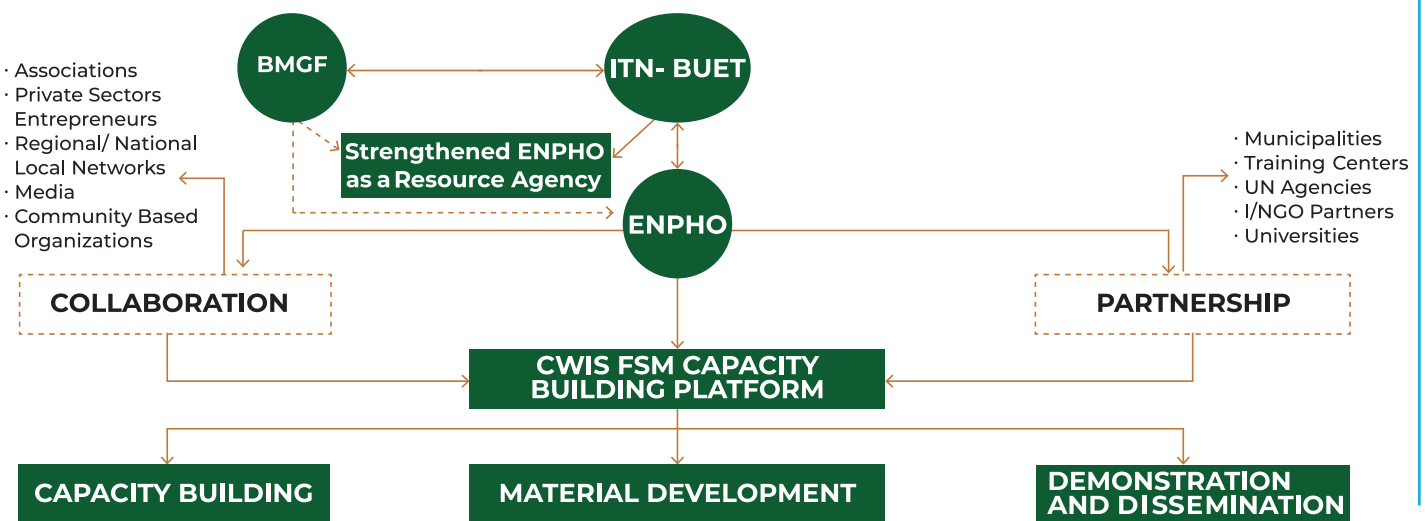


**PROJECT AREAS**
